



The Red Zone Questions & Answers

Q. What is the Red Zone?

A. The Red Zone is a group of Christian men who are retired or near retirement that meet together for fellowship, personal & spiritual growth and service. The Red Zone requires no commitment. Just drop-in when you are able.

Q. How often do they meet?

A. The Red Zone meets on the third Monday night of each month at 7:00 pm at Keystone Church. In addition, on the 2nd and 4th Friday of each month a group of guys meet at 7:30am for breakfast at [Bob Evans on Saline/Ann Arbor Road](#).

Q. How long is each meeting?

A. The group is committed to ending the meetings by 9:00 pm.

Q. What are the meetings like?

- A. There are generally four types of meetings:
- Someone from the group makes a presentation followed by group discussion.
 - A topic is presented with group discussion.
 - An outside speaker makes a presentation and followed by Q&A.
 - The meeting is devoted to food and fellowship.
