Dear Keystone Church Family,

What an amazing start to Spring this year at Keystone! We had six people who made a decision to trust Christ as their Savior on Palm Sunday and celebrated the baptism of five people on Easter Sunday with 1,151 people in attendance. If you were here on Easter Sunday, it was easy to see how crowded we were and how nice it will be next year to have the additional 144 seats in our auditorium thanks to the ReOrient Campaign.

Speaking of the ReOrient campaign, in case you missed it, on April 7<sup>th</sup> we announced that we exceeded our financial goal as our church family committed to giving over \$2.6 million dollars toward the campaign in the next two years. We have selected a construction management firm and are moving forward with plans to begin construction this summer. We will update you as construction plans are firmed up. We hope to have minimal disruptions to normal ministry activities.

If you write one check with your regular giving plus additional funds for the campaign, please note in the memo field how much is for the campaign by writing "ReOrient" and then the amount. Any checks without a memo field that contains "ReOrient" will be directed to our general fund and not the campaign. The same applies to online giving transactions as well.

On Sunday, May 12<sup>th</sup> we will be saying goodbye to our Family Ministry Resident, Erin Strakalaitis, as she moves to Marion, Indiana to pursue a Masters of Divinity degree from Wesleyan Seminary. Pastor Erin has been an amazing part of our team the past two years and we are so thankful for her passion for Christ, love for students, children and their families, and all the energy and joy she brought to Keystone. We will miss her but are excited about the next chapter she will begin this Summer.

The Keystone Annual Meeting is scheduled for Sunday, May 19<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 pm. Everyone who attends Keystone is welcome to come but we especially request that all members attend as we will be voting on the makeup of the Keystone Leadership Team (Board of Elders) and the annual budget. We will also be discussing our plans for the coming year of ministry and a progress report on the ReOrient Campaign. We hope to see you there!
