We feel that Baptism by immersion paints the truest picture of “dying to sin and rising to Christ and new life.” We strongly encourage those choosing to be baptized to participate by immersion. We do recognize, however, that some individuals may request Baptism by sprinkling because of a strong personal preference, particularly those based on a compelling physical reason or disability. In these cases, we ask that a brief explanation be provided.
